Universal access to Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen

Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen is a public-friendly museum and places great importance on universal accessibility. Below you will find an overview of facilities for visitors who require assistance. The gallery numbers refer to the plan of the museum that you will receive at the reception desk. Feel free to ask the museum staff for assistance at any time during your visit.

Entrances

The museum has two entrances: the exhibitions entrance and the collections entrance. Only the collections entrance in the courtyard (Museumpark 18) has wheelchair access. From here you can visit both the exhibitions and the collections. The collections entrance is the original entrance dating from 1935 and is accessed via steps.

From the entrance you can access the following areas without using stairs:

- galleries A and B
- the collections of 20th-century art and design on the ground floor. To access gallery 42, use the entrance via gallery 48
- the shop
- the restaurant
- the accessible toilets
- the ArtStudio

Via the lift in gallery A you can access:

- the exhibitions in galleries C-I on the first floor
- the permanent collection of fine art from the Middle Ages to the early 20th century (galleries 5-39). Gallery 5 can be accessed from gallery 36 via gallery 13.

With a stairlift (ask the invigilators for assistance) you can access:

- the auditorium
- gallery G

Via the lift in the restaurant you can access:

The following spaces are not accessible for wheelchair users

- galleries 1-4
- gallery 40
- the library

Availability of wheelchairs and baby buggies

3 wheelchairs and 2 baby buggies are available from the reception desk. You can request one on arrival or reserve one in advance by calling +31 (0)10 441 9400.

Accessible toilets

The museum has 3 accessible toilets, on the ground floor in gallery 53 and in gallery 50.

Service dogs

Service dogs are welcome in the museum.

Parking near the museum

There are two disabled parking spaces in front of the museum. They may be used free of charge as long as your disabled parking permit is clearly displayed behind the windscreen. It is not possible to reserve a parking space.

Regular parking around the museum is limited and can be paid for only with a chip card and/or credit card (master/visa). The closest car park is at Museumpark 32.

Disaster plan

The museum has a disaster plan, which includes an evacuation plan for people who require assistance. In case of a disaster, please speak to one of the invigilators.
